Don't be late, be up to date!

- Schedule your child's physical and dental appointments in early spring
- Bring child's shot records from the doctor's office and/or Health Department
- Remember to keep copies of your child's records

Parents, will your child be ready for the first day of school?

Preschool

- Physical
- Lead Screening (blood test strongly recommended)
- 1 Hib vaccine (1 or more doses)
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine OR immunity proof
- Proof of age appropriate Pneumococcal vaccine (s)
- 3 Polio Vaccines
- 3 Hepatitis B vaccines
- TB Screening
- 4 DTaP vaccines
- 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)

Kindergarten

- 2 MMR vaccines (K-12)
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines OR immunity proof (K thru 4th)
- 3 or more doses of Polio vaccine (booster on or after 4th birthday)
- 4 or more doses of DTaP (booster on or after 4th birthday)
- Lead Screening (blood test strongly recommended)
- Physical
- Lead Screening
- Eye Exam
- Dental Exam

2nd & 6th Grades

- Dental Exam

6th Grade

- Physical
- 1 Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine given on or after 11th birthday (6th thru 9th)
- 1 Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) vaccine (6th thru 12th)
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines OR immunity proof (6th thru 12th)
- 2 MMR vaccines
- 3 Hepatitis vaccines (proof series completed)

9th Grade

- Physical
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines OR immunity proof (9th thru 12th)

12th Grade

- Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine(s)
 - * 2 doses with second dose at age 16 or later
 - * 1 dose if given at age 16 or later

Other recommended vaccines

- HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) vaccine: ages 11-12 and older if not yet completed
- Hepatitis A vaccine if not yet completed
